



**JOB TITLE:**

Semi Service Driver

**LOCATION:**

Recycle Ann Arbor Recovery Yard, 7891 Jackson Rd.

**FLSA STATUS:**

This position is considered a full-time union, non-exempt position for purposes of federal wage-hour law.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

Under the direction of Dispatch and responsible to the Site Supervisor, the Semi Service Driver will be responsible for hauling recycling and construction debris to and from the Recovery Yard. The Semi Service Driver is responsible for performing assigned duties on container delivery and hauling of industrial roll-off routes. This position involves entering and exiting a heavy-duty truck numerous times each day. In addition, the position involves lifting, pushing and pulling up to 100 pounds.

Duties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Attention to safety at all times including the safe operation of roll-off equipment (semi-tractor trailer and straight truck.)
- Driving and operation of roll-off equipment on daily routes, including:
  - Pick up full roll-off containers at Drop Off Station, Community Clean Ups and other satellite locations, including residential and business sites, and transport them to the Company's Recovery Yard and landfills for disposal;
  - Drop off empty roll-off containers at Drop Off Station, Community Clean Ups, the Recovery Yard, and other satellite locations;
  - Perform daily pre/post-trip truck/trailer inspections;
  - Comply with all local, state, and federal transportation regulations and with Company policies;
  - Maintain cleanliness of interior and exterior of assigned truck;
  - Inspect full roll off containers to ensure that all materials are safe for transport;
  - Transport 48 foot walking floor semi trailer and various-sized roll off containers (10 cu. Yard to 90 cu. Yard).
- Other duties as assigned.
- Occasional weekend work required

**JOB REQUIREMENTS:**

The successful candidate must possess the following job requirements:

- Must have a valid Michigan Class A CDL with airbrakes endorsement;
- Minimum three years of experience in the trucking industry;
- Ability to communicate with a diverse customer base, and have exceptional, demonstrated customer service skills;
- Ability to work within and contribute to a teamwork environment;
- Ability to work independently;
- Ability to frequently lift, push or pull up to 100 pounds;
- Ability to perform physical requirements of the position with or without reasonable accommodations.
- Maintain a professional appearance and attitude;
- Be flexible and adaptable to change;
- Clean driving record;
- Legally eligible to work in the United States;
- Successfully pass pre-employment (post offer) drug screen, background and motor vehicle records check and Department of Transportation Physical.
