Curbside Recycling Services

If you have moved into the **City of Ann Arbor**, **your curbside recycling service is provided by Recycle Ann Arbor**. If you didn't have a cart on-site already, please call 734-662-6288 to get one or with any questions. **Your trash and yard waste are collected by the City of Ann Arbor: 734-994-2807.**

Township Residents should call their local Township Hall for information on curbside services and waste haulers.

If you don't have access to curbside recycling you can bring all your typical curbside recycling to the Drop-Off Station or the Recovery Yard for recycling.

These disposal options, and more, are outlined in this brochure.

Pick-Up & Rental Services

Recycle Ann Arbor’s **ReUse Center** offers a **free collection service** for customers who have *good* quality furniture they are unable to take to their new home. To find out if your items qualify for free collection call the **ReUse Center at 734-222-7880**.

If your items are not eligible for the free pick up service, **the Drop Off Station will pick-up up to 5 cubic yards** of waste, recycling and furniture for a maximum fee of \$175.00. Alternatively you can rent a 5 cubic yard trailer for 48 hours. Call the **Drop-Off Station at 734-971-7400** for more information.

Clearing a large basement or garage? Our Recovery Yard rents 10– 40 cubic yard Roll-Offs. Every container is sorted to maximize recycling. **Call the Recovery Yard at 734-426-2280** for more information.

“Difficult” to Recycle Items

When moving, people find outdated items or things no longer needed, which are often difficult to recycle at the curb. These items typically include:

- CRT Televisions and old electronics
- Old Household Appliances
- CFLs and Fluorescent Tubes
- Waste Motor Oil
- Old Paperwork, Invoices, Tax Returns
- Old Refrigerators and Freezers
- Mattresses

All of these items can be responsibly recycled at Recycle Ann Arbor’s **Drop-Off Station** and **Recovery Yard**. Both sites also offer secure document and hard drive destruction.

Need Packing Materials?

Recycle Ann Arbor prioritizes reuse above recycling whenever possible. The **Drop-Off Station** offers low cost packaging materials such as cardboard boxes, bubble wrap, and packing peanuts. Stock varies due to demand. Call for more information, **734-971-7400**.

Home Toxics Reduction Program

None of Recycle Ann Arbor’s sites take home toxics. Home toxics should be taken to Washtenaw County’s Home Toxic Collection at 705 N Zeeb Rd. See www.ewashtenaw.gov for more information or call 734-222-6874.

Recycling Your Packaging Materials

For a \$3.00 entry fee the following packaging materials can be recycled at the Drop-Off Station if you can’t find a way to reuse them.

- Packing Paper
- Styrofoam*
- Packing Peanuts*
- Cardboard Boxes
- Bubble Wrap*
- Plastic bags and wrap*

Separating your different materials in advance will save time on-site.

****These items can not go into many curbside recycling collections and are not accepted at the Recovery Yard.***

Curbside Recycling Extra Services

For residents in the City of Ann Arbor, we can often schedule a one-time (free) extra pick-up of cardboard. Additional extra pick-ups may be arranged for a fee. Call 734.662.6288.
